# Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

#### Overview

Hillfoot Fields comprises of:

- 97 private sale homes
- 53 pre-sold homes
- An equipped play area
- A balancing feature

### Development activity

- Footpaths are due to be completed by Spring 2025
- The play area is to be completed by Winter 2024
- The balancing feature is due to be completed by Spring 2025
- The proposed school site is owned by others

### **Planning**

Some Permitted Development Rights have been removed so changes to garages and roofs/lofts cannot be undertaken without planning permission from the Local Authority

#### **Timeline**

- Road and footpath remedial works are due to be completed Spring 2025
- The play area is to be completed by Winter 2024
- The balancing feature is to be completed by Spring 2025
- The access gate to Elm Road will be reviewed in Autumn 2024

## Managing agent

All homes at Hillfoot Fields are subject to an estate charge.

A Dandy Wren have been instructed by Vistry as the managing agent. This charge covers the maintenance of the open public spaces including the equipped play area.

- We will be providing swift boxes to plots 2, 7, 25, 29, 42, 45, 46, 80, 85, 119, 132 and 150
- We will be providing bat boxes to plots 27, 28, 52, 65, 66, 106, 107, 109, 120, 125, 128 and 129
- We will be installing an acoustic fence to the boundary of the football club
- The following plots will be fitted with photovoltaic panels, of which ownership transfers to the homeowner on completion: 25, 27-29, 31, 33, 42, 43-44, 67-69, 71-75, 80-81, 83-84, 86-89 and 110-118



### **Services**

Open Fibre Networks limited (OFNL) have been appointed to provide fibre for broadband to properties on this development. British Telecom is not available on this development.
