Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

The development will provide local facilities including a community centre with kitchen, hall and changing rooms, a junior football pitch and an equipped play area. These areas along with the public open space and balancing features at the front of the development will be transferred to and maintained by Olney town council.

Yardley Manor comprises of:

- 88 private sale homes
- A community football pitchA BMX track
- 37 pre-sold homes
- An equipped play area Public open space
- A play area
- A community centre
- Balancing features
- A public art feature

Development activity

- The public art feature will be installed in Spring 2025
- The play area, equipped play area and BMX track are due to open 2024
- The community centre and community football pitch are due to open in Spring 2025



Timeline

- The play area, equipped play area and BMX track are due to be open 2024
- The community centre is due to open Spring 2025
- The community football pitch is due to be open Spring 2025
- The public art will be installed in Spring 2025
- The roads and footpaths are due to be completed Autumn 2025

Management company

The following properties with private lighting will be members of the Management Company and have a service charge to cover the cost of running and maintaining the lighting columns:

Plots 4 -7, 18 -24, 35 -36, 39 -48, 93 -96, 101 -103, 112 -115, and 124 -125.

Anticipated handover date to the Management Company is June 2024

Development information

Bird boxes to plots: 6, 26, 53, 74, 76, 81, 104 and 111 Bat bricks to plots: 4, 12, 27, 82 and 123 Provision of hedgehog highways

Solar Photovoltaic Systems (PV panels) These are fitted to the following plots: 5, 17, 24, 36, 41, 42, 44, 102, 103, 116, 117, 118
