Bay View in Northam

Bay View is a beautiful development of two, three, four and five bedroom homes, with spectacular far-reaching views over Bideford and Westward Ho!

Parts of the site are allocated for future school land and community centre land.

Site activity



- A play park has been created and is now open.
- As part of the required highway improvements, a cycleway is currently being constructed on Buckleigh Road and
 what is known locally as Daddon Hill Lane to the south of the site. The road now just needs to be tarmacked. Once this
 is completed, all construction traffic will access the site from Buckleigh Road, instead of Bay View Road.
- The sewers and storm drains in phase one are connected and have been inspected by South West Water. Section 104 agreements are in place and the adoption of drainage on site will take place when the site is more advanced and more occupations have taken place.
- Footpaths have been topped to occupied areas (homes 130-124, 115-120, 1-32 and 38-72) and remaining footpaths will be topped in line with the last completions.
- There is an existing farm that currently sits vacant on parts of the site, which is due to be demolished this autumn (work is anticipated to start on 1st October).
- All the roads on the first phase are due to be finished this winter.
- Phase one is expected to be completed in summer 2025.
- Work on phase two started in November 2023 and the second phase will include air source heat pumps.





Archaeology

The final archaeological works are taking place at the development. All other areas of the site have been investigated and no further action is required.

Ecology

- Bird and bat boxes will be housed on the development to encourage habitat corridors.
- Wildflower meadow planting is also being added to the development.
- •There will also be an orchard at the bottom of the site.

Attenuation basins

Two attenuation basins have been constructed in phase one. They are designed to capture any excess surface water and release it to natural watercourses at a controlled rate.

How will the development benefit the local community?

As part of the development's first phase, Bovis Homes is contributing to the local community by providing land for a new school; improved infrastructure works along Bay View Road; £7,800 will be available for library services; £25,740 for early years education; and £433,160 towards primary school education.
