Site activity

- Construction is progressing in accordance with the schedule, estimated as 15% build completion on site.
- Mains have been installed on the Spine Road through the development.
- Storm and foul drainage systems have been installed and live.
- First privately owned occupants moved in October 2024.
- Show homes and sales centre opened July 2024.

Overview

Bovis Homes at Priors Hall Park consists of 151 2, 3, 4 & 5 bedroom homes within a larger consortium development close to Corby.

Located in the northern area of Northamptonshire, Corby is a growing town with plenty to offer. The new homes are just an eight-minute drive to the town centre, which has a good range of shops. You can also get the number 2 bus which takes as little as 20 minutes.

About Priors Hall Park Project & Community:

The wider Priors Hall Park project, which is being delivered across three zones on a 907-acre site by a consortium of housebuilders, is set to bring 5,325 new homes, alongside new schools, shops, community facilities, open spaces and sports pitches.

The Biodiversity Strategy has been developed to provide biodiversity opportunities and enhancements within the development. There are several bird and bat boxes installed on site. Please speak to your Sales Consultant for more information on exact locations


