## Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

### St Congar's Place in Congresbury

The development will also provide:

- A play area and a trim trail
- 15 affordable homes for Alliance Homes, including a property built to support a homeowner with disabilities
- A footpath along Wrington Lane, from the site to Kent Road, which forms part of our off-site S278 works
- Photovoltaic/solar panels on 60% of homes
- Electrical vehicle charging points to various homes

### Managing agent

The managing agent is Remus and the management company is St Congar's Place Management Company.

We expect to handover the development to the managing agent in 2025 and you will receive additional communication from them directly.

- British Gas (gas and electric)
- Bristol Water (water)
- BT (broadband)



## Congresbury Youth Club is looking youthful again thanks to volunteers

Congresbury Youth Club has been given a fresh coat of paint, thanks to a team of our volunteers.

Alex Ballard, chair of Congresbury Youth Club, commented: “Bovis Homes was inspired by Kind Congresbury to volunteer a kindness to the village. Their volunteers and their subcontractor Prodec have done a very nice job at Congresbury Youth Club, providing all the labour and materials for a repaint of the outside. We’re very grateful for the support as it means our money can be spent directly on initiatives for young people. Thank you!”

Congresbury Youth Club is an important part of the community and organises open access youth sessions for young people aged eight to 16.

### Site activity and updates

- The development is now 70% sold.
- The play park is now open and the trim trail will be delivered next year.
- The roads will be topped in phases throughout the next couple of years.
- Streetlights are being connected as we progress through the site and we aim to connect the lighting prior to occupation.
- There will be an attenuation basin on site, which is designed to capture any excess surface water and release it to a watercourse at a controlled rate.

### Ecology

- Bird and bat boxes will be housed throughout the development.
- There is a tree preservation order on the oak tree at the bottom of the site and we will be retaining the mature hedgerows wherever possible.
- Enhanced landscape planting will feature throughout the development and an area will be available for cows to graze, benefitting the local ecosystem.
