Keeping you updated

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Site Activity

- Currently 150 roofs now on
- Installation of the SANG area is coming along well with a staged handover to The Land Trust anticipated to start by May, once the area has dried
- First completions with LEAF and Abri anticipated in March.

Overview

Broxborough Park will be bringing to the local community:

- 184 Homes with a mixture of private homes, rented and Shared Ownership.
- Four blocks of apartments, available on affordable homes rented, shared ownership and the First Homes scheme.
- A large Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace (SANG) area with playgrounds, paths and an orchard.
- Outline planning permission for GP surgery (to be built by another developer).
- Onsite LAP (Local Area for Play) totalling 200m.
- Share Drive parking scheme.

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Timeline

- Q1 25 first initial handovers to Abri homes and Leaf PRS
- Q1 25 Completion of our Sales Area and Show Homes
- Q1 25 First stage of the SANG Handover to The Land trust
- Q2 25 First private completions
- Q2 25 Ongoing LEAF PRS and Abri Homes Completions
- Q2 25 Next large area opening to the public

Managing agent

- Trinity Estates will be the management agent for the development.
- Parts of the development will be handed over to Trinity to manage on a phase-by-phase basis.
- The Managing Agent is the company responsible for the upkeep and ongoing maintenance of the development

Ecology

- •We have two badger sets across the development which have exclusion zones set up around them. This is to ensure we have no interaction with the sets and they are not disturbed
- •Gully bags are being used to prevent silt in water streams throughout the development
- Environmental toolbox talks being carried out with those working onsite with our specialist ecology advisor
- •The development is also home to lots of natural habitats. We have ensured to leave behind a positive mark with some of the new homes having their own Ecology habitat installed into the façade or local area
