

We wanted to provide you with an update on the development and what you can expect from us over the coming months.

Overview

Summary of what's being built:

- 88 Homes, 33 of which are affordable
- Attenuation basin
- Photovoltaic panels and EV charging
- New sub station
- New pumping station

Site activity

- 64 homes currently in construction, 29 of which are affordable homes
- Out of the homes currently under construction, we have stages of build varying from foundations to finishes.

Drainage update

 We're working very closely with Bellway Homes to ensure all drainage such as foul and storm water are connected and complete into the main line, along with getting the pump station up and running.

- The roads and footpaths to the site are progressing well with many of the off site works now complete.

- Newt fencing remains in place and will be removed in sections in agreement with the ecologists as construction progresses
